Deposit & Final Payment: An initial deposit must be paid at the time the reservation is originated. The cancellation schedule observed will be that of the respective provider (airline, cruise line, tour operator, or transportation provider etc. as the case may be) of travel services ("Supplier"). Prices are subject to change due to fuel charges and other Supplier charges. Airline tickets purchased are non-refundable. Final payment is due as per the Travel Leaders Vacation Center ("TLVC") invoice provided. Once the final payment is paid, the booking becomes non-refundable.

Cancellation Policy: The deposit cancellation policy observed will be the Supplier's current policy.
